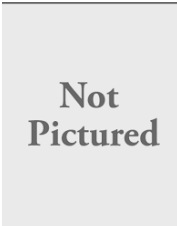
Mattie Boggs

Mikenna Dushane

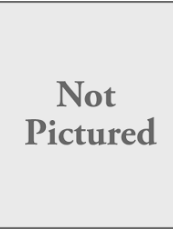
